

Things that are a must at January 2022.

We return to Pre-school on Thursday 6th January 2022.

On arrival at the pre-school carpark, please stand at your car, until you and your child are called over to the main entrance by April. Please say goodbye to your child at the door and tell them you will be back later to pick them up. A staff member will take your child into the foyer and help them to sanitise their hands and guide them into the main hall.

We ask all new parents/carers to be at home or local for the first 2 weeks of your child attending Pre-school. In the rare case of a child not settling, we would want to contact the parent, for an earlier collection. The Pre-school telephone number is 07719969245.

Pick up will be in the garden for the first half term so if you could all enter the garden via the back gates at 12 noon or 3pm the children will be let out to you. Staff will be on hand to let you know how your child got on and will be available to answer any questions.

All children are required to have a named rucksack containing a change of clothes. This rucksack will be kept at Pre-school for the duration of each half term and any wet or soiled clothes will be bagged and handed to you on pick up. We ask that you replace the clothes the next session your child attends.

All children that are in nappies must also provide 5 nappies, nappy sacks and wipes in the named rucksack as well. You will be notified by a staff member when your child is running low on any of the above.

Please provide your child with a named re-fillable water bottle on their first session, this can be put in their rucksacks and a staff member will take it out and show your child where it is kept and how to access the water dispenser to fill it up. These bottles will remain at Pre-school and will be cleaned daily by a staff member.

All children must bring a named pair of wellies on their first session, these will be kept at Pre-school and returned every half term for you to make sure the size has not changed with your child. Please bring along these wellies at the first session your child attends and at the beginning of each new half term.

Please do not send your child into Pre-school with open-toed sandals or a top that does not cover their back and shoulders. We want to keep your child safe and protected when accessing the outside environment during the hotter months.

Sun cream must be applied before arrival at pre-school and we will top it up during the session depending on the weather. A named sunhat is needed too. Please put this in your child's rucksack. This too will remain at Pre-school.

Please ensure your child is appropriately dressed in the colder months, bearing in mind the hall windows will be open at all times to ensure maximum ventilation as a precaution for Covid-19.

Please provide your child with a named woolly hat and gloves on their first session in their rucksack. These will be moved to the winter hat/gloves box so your child can access them on a daily basis when going outside in the colder months. All hats/gloves will remain at Pre-school for the duration of your child's time with us.

If your child is staying for lunch please ensure it is in a clearly named lunch box/bag. There is no need for a lunch drink bottle as they can access their daily drinks bottle for lunchtime.

If your child has a comforter or favourite toy and they are starting with us in January 2022, please put it in their rucksack and the staff and the child can access it if needed to help settle them in.

Please put a family photograph, a photo of your house and a photo of any pets you have in an envelope in your child's rucksack on the first session they attend. We will access these with your child and together we will put them on the family noticeboard. Please do not forget as the children feel comfort, familiarity and pride in pointing and chatting about their identified family, house and pets. This board can be accessed at all times throughout the session. It is the children's very own board and they visit it frequently.
